

FOOD & LIFE COMPANIES has introduced a scholarship program for university students.

As part of our activities aimed at providing a comfortable work environment for the people we work with at FOOD & LIFE COMPANIES (F&LC), we have newly started financial support through a scholarship that does not need to be repaid, starting October 2021, so that our colleagues in our workplace do not have to give up their college education due to unfavorable financial circumstances.

[Eligibility]

Applicants who meet all of the following conditions are eligible for the scholarship.

- Applicants must be working at a store run by F&LC group.
- Applicants must be either in their 1st, 2nd or 3rd year at a four-year college (excluding distance learning and evening school) in Japan
- Applicants must be a recipient of a scholarship (a grant or a loan) provided by Japan Student Services Organization.
- Applicants whose annual household income is under 4 million JPY.

[Application / Screening Process]

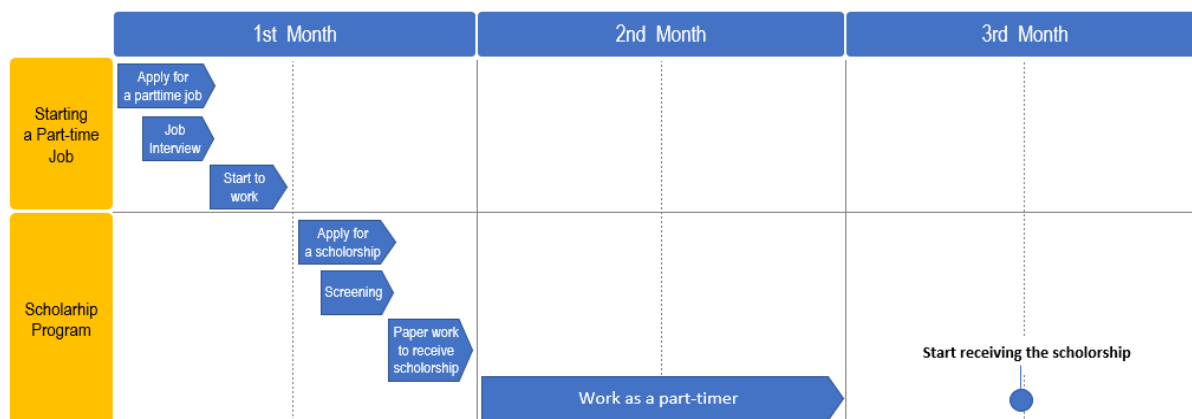
- If you wish to apply for F&LC scholarship, you must first apply for a part-time job at a store (Sushiro, Kyotaru, Kaisen-Misakiko, Sugidaama, etc.) operated by F&LC group, and be hired.
Once you are hired, you can apply for the scholarship through “JINJI-BU LINE@.”
Then, application paper screening and interviews will follow.

[Scholarship Payment]

- 20,000 JPY will be paid every month (which will not need to be repaid)
- No condition (attached to this scholarship) regarding a career path after graduation of college

[Timeline]

- After you passed the screening/interview and win the scholarship, the scholarship payment starts in the 3rd month, counting from the month you applied for the program.
